Saturday, 9<sup>th</sup> October - Golden Beach Family Day - end Steve D's marathon march with a massive sausage sizzle.

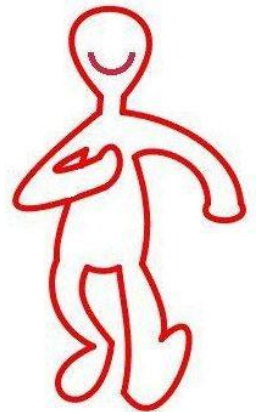

Four days to raise the \$98,500 needed to keep the station viable for the year ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2011.

Last financial year we conducted two campaigns six months apart. A successful “**mPower Twenty-10**” will mean just one campaign for the year.

I'm asking you to take our need to God between now and then to prepare the way for God's blessing and favour to be poured out. We need Him – all the time, 24/7 – to survive and to continue to improve.

Over the past three years our sound has improved markedly. I believe we now provide professional quality, Spirit-filled programming. And you are bound to have noticed that most of our programmes are now presenter-led.

We have added more talk back programmes. Local content has increased. Many more 'locally grown' Christian artists and ministry & teaching programmes are featured. There are popular programmes featuring teachers such as Joyce Meyer, Michael Youssef, Ravi Zacharias, Chuck Missler, Chuck Swindoll, and David Pawson. And of course there is the outstanding Focus on the Family programme.

Our passion is to broadcast 'life changing radio' and we are continually being encouraged by listeners sharing how much they appreciate and enjoy our programmes, how they have been blessed through 106five Rhema FM, how their lives have been changed for the better.

The Word of God is living and active and sharper than any 2-edged sword, piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart (Hebrews 4:12). It is our privilege to be a source of this 'Good News' for God's people across our broadcast footprint covering the Sunshine Coast and reaching into North Brisbane.

Radio is free to air but it is not free to produce. It costs! Rent, electricity, internet and telephone communication cost, insurances, software, hardware, royalties for every song that goes to air, stationary, postage, The

Word for Today, marketing and a very limited number of salaried personnel are just some of the costs.

We are a community radio station. We are membership driven (and we seek more members, we need to keep growing our numbers to make it clear to ACMA, the authority that grants licences and reviews them every 5 years, that we are deserving of a licence, meeting the community of interest we serve, Christians).

Our on-air revenue earning ability is limited by ACMA. No more than 5 minutes per hour can be used for 'sponsorship', in layman's terms, advertising, and so membership and financial giving are integral to our survival and improvement.

So to close: I appeal for your support. Prayer between now and the 6<sup>th</sup> October, to prepare the way. Participation 6<sup>th</sup> through to the 9<sup>th</sup> October. Together we can make a difference.

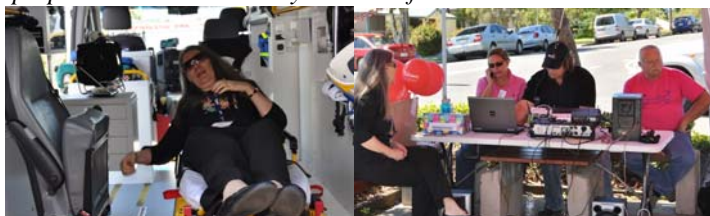

### The Unchangeableness of God.

"I the Lord change not; therefore you sons of Jacob are not consumed." Malachi 3:6

The Unchangeableness of God. What an anchor for a storm tossed sea! "Change is our portion here!" Scenes are altering. Joys are fading. It is covenant love which is now darkening my earthly horizon. This hour He is the same as when He "spared not His own Son!" Oh, instead of wondering at my trials, let me rather wonder that He has borne with me so long. It is of the Lord's unchanging mercies that I am not consumed. Had He been man, changeable, vacillating, as myself, long before now would He have spurned me away, and consigned me to the doom of the cumberer. But, "My thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, says the Lord." He is without any variableness.
